# LIE FHUNG

artist CV



Lie Fhung (b. 1969 in Jakarta, Indonesia) studied fine arts at the Bandung Institute of Technology in West Java, majoring in Ceramics. After graduating, Fhung found herself grappling with questions of artistic and cultural identity, which stymied her creative work. She left Indonesia to work as a designer in Shanghai and eventually settled in Hong Kong, where she began to work independently in digital media design. Fhung's engagement in activities beyond the pure scope of art helped her to forge networks that have come to inspire her art-making processes. For example, through her digital scrapbooking business *Ztampf!*, she was privileged to gain insight into the small visual histories that women, especially mothers, created for themselves and their families. In her role as artist she explored with them the question of what is hidden from these histories, an exploration that influenced her multi-media project *To Breed or Not to Breed* (2005-2009).

In her works, she investigates private matters, hidden layers within dreams, memories and human body (especially female's), human emotions and their drives. The way they work and affect us, their mysteries and wonders are some of things she has been exploring. Art making is her way to contemplate and to bear witness to personal stories. As an artist, she thrives in exploring and working with diverse materials from porcelain to paint, metal, fabric, and digital prints, which

are often presented in the form of installations. For her, the act of creating is a matter of existence and survival.

Lie Fhung has received numerous national and international prizes and awards for her artworks since childhood. She has participated in national and international art exhibitions, recognised for the delicate tactile sensibility that infuses much of her work. She was the recipient of a Freeman Fellowship Award which entitled her to a 2-month fully supported Artist Residency at Vermont Studio Center in the US in 2008. Her work 'flight' is featured in the 'Contemporary Ceramics' book by Emmanuel Cooper, published by Thames & Hudson in 2009. In 2015, she was awarded Silver Prize by UOB Art Academy Hong Kong. Her latest, very-well received, solo exhibition was held at Dia.lo.gue art space, Jakarta in late 2017.

She has been showing her works in Hong Kong at Sin Sin Fine Art since 2012, and more recently at Hanart TZ Gallery.

She has moved back to live in Indonesia since early 2023.
